Our children need to know this and to be reassured that they don't have the problem, instead it is the bully with the problem. Also encourage your child to let an adult know at the time, so we can help. Bullying will only stop when the victim feels empowered to ignore it and not become a victim. It is a good message to learn from a very young age because bullying continues into adult life and we are hearing more about cyber bullying than ever before.
