PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Greenwell Point Public School if this is your first week with us and welcome back to all our wonderful children and their families. I trust you had a safe and happy holiday or at least enjoyed the change in routine.

New parents please remember to look in your child's bag each Monday afternoon for the newsletter. It is sent home every week and the day only changes if the children have been away from school. The newsletter is the major way of communicating with parents. A copy is also placed on the school web page.

Mrs Spelta will be testing Kindergarten children this Wednesday and Thursday. I will be taking the class while this important task is completed. My role will continue as a support for learning, librarian and teaching the classes for the classroom teachers 2 hour release from face to face teaching each week. Mr Bourke has taken leave for 2 terms and will be replaced by Mr Ian Cunningham. Mr Wilkinson will again be with us this year replacing Mrs Baker who is enjoying raising her 3 sons.

I mentioned last year that our numbers are on the growth again and although the boom isn't expected until 2016-17 (all the new siblings born last year) we still have an imbalance in the lower end. What we really need right now is a boost of about 10 children and then we would qualify for a 4th teacher. But until such time we have put a lot of time into organising the classes for this year based on needs and ability. I will be working closely with Mr Wilkinson and Mr Cunningham to make sure we gain the best for ever child's learning. As it stands we will have a Kinder Year 1 class, a Year 1, 2, 3 class and a 3,4,5,6 class. There are many benefits for the combinations and we hope you will agree that we have made good choices for the combinations based on our knowledge of you child. However please bring any concerns to me ASAP so we can discuss them and help make the right adjustments if required.

All parents have received the back to school payment, so please help the teachers and students by purchasing the text books as soon possible. This payment by the government, is given in good faith that the parents will support their children to have all the necessary equipment to learn. A good education is a gift for life please help.
