MEAL DEAL this Wednesday. There will be a meal deal consisting of Pie, popper and fruit for \$5. We will not be using the normal canteen menu.

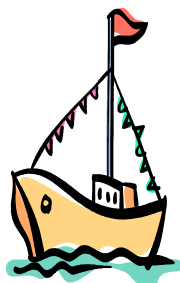


P&C NEWS
