PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are concerned about some of the food being sent to school with students. At the moment we are seeing lots of potato chips, lollies and chewing gum. At school and as part of our health education we are encouraging students to eat healthy things as studies show this helps with their energy and concentration levels. Some suggestions are 1 or 2 sandwiches or wraps, 2 pieces of fruit/vegetables and 1 or 2 snacks such as muesli bars, sultanas/dried fruit or cracker biscuits with a spread. Chewing gum is banned at school.
