### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Flu season is still here!

At this time of the year we are noticing a lot of absences due to the flu, we ask that you keep your child home if they are feeling unwell, but we also ask that you either ring the school office and let us know that he or she will be away or send in a quick note when they return to school, it is our obligation to record if a student is away and also if it is an unexplained absence.

Influenza is spread from person-to-person through the coughing or sneezing of infected people. Remind your child about these good hygiene practices to minimise the spread of infection:

- Anyone who is sick with influenza symptoms should stay home until their symptoms are gone.
- Cover the nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing or sneezing. Throw the tissue in the garbage bin after use.
- Wash hands often with soap and water, especially after coughing or sneezing. Alcohol-based hands cleaners are also effective.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread that way.

If you or your child develops influenza-like illness, seek the advice of your family doctor as you would with any other illness.

On another note I would just like to take this opportunity to thank the Greenwell Point Fishing & Oyster Festival Committee for their wonderful commitment to making this one of our best fetes/festival we have ever held, but we still need the on going support from our parents, as many hands make light work.

Don't forget to have a spring clean during the holidays as we are after these sorts of items for our White Elephant Stall to resell and also for our Tombola and Plant Stalls.
