Dear Parents and Guardians.

Several years ago, Kids Korner Occasional Care centre in Nowra ran a bus to the school in the afternoons to collect children and offered after school care for working parents. There was a cost for the service. It was a very reliable service and the parents who used it thought it was great. However as children left the school, the service became less viable and eventually it stopped. This service is based on families having a regular care day not just needing this service every now and then and a minimum number is required to provide this service.
