Our school follows the Positive Behaviour for Learning Program (PBL) which classifies behaviour into Minor or Major events. If a child is brought to the attention of the teacher on duty for inappropriate behaviour the event is recorded in the Attention book. The purpose of this record is to provide follow up with parents. If a child's name is recorded three times then a letter is sent home. If the behaviour is constant and/or serious you would already have been contacted.
