WAYS TO HELP OUR SCHOOL AND YOUR CHILDREN



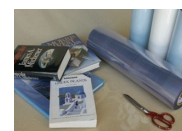
- Let Mrs Miller or Mrs Hiscox know you are available to help in the canteen on a Friday.
