0-6 months, approved rearward facing child car seat,
6 months-4years, approved rear or forward facing child car seats

Disobey no stopping sign (school zone) \$325 & 2 demerit points

Disobey no parking sign (school zone) \$180 & 2 demerit points

INTERSECTIONS/CROSSINGS

Stop on/near children's crossing (school zone) \$433 & 2 demerit points

Stop on/near pedestrian crossing (school zone) \$433 & 2 demerit points

Stop on/near marked foot crossing (school zone) \$433 & 2 demerit points

Stop on path/strip in built-up area (school zone) \$180 & 2 demerit points
 Stop on painted island (school zone) \$180 & 2 demerit points
 Stop on traffic island (school zone) \$180 & 2 demerit points
 Stop on/across driveway/other access to/from land (school zone) \$180 & 2 demerit points
