STEPS—KINDERGARTEN EYE TESTING

StEPS is a free NSW Health service offered to all childcare and day care centres with the aim of screening the vision of all children who are 4 years of age or older (who have not previously had the vision screen). This health check is part of the child's NSW blue book check and is highly recommended for all eligible children particularly before they head into school.

In Term 1 we offer our service in primary schools to:

- 1. Screen any kindergarten children that did not attend child care last year
- 2. Screen any children who missed out on the screening at their preschool

PLEASE NOTE: the screening is ONLY for children that HAVE NOT already been screened – over 80% of children would have had their vision screened at preschool.
