Dear Parents and Carers,

Exciting news! Today we were informed we have been the recipients of a \$10,000.00 grant from ANZ Tennis Hotshots. Mrs Bowman made a small video about the school when she applied for the grant and it was viewed and voted as the winner. This money will assist us with fundraising for our new hard outdoor playing surface and brings us just that little bit closer to realising our vision. The next 2 weeks are proving to be jammed packed full of activities as we wind our way into the Easter school holidays.
