Dear Parents and Carers,

Last week we had the Life Education van visiting our school to coincide with what is taught in the Personal Development and Physical Education syllabus in classrooms. The students enjoyed seeing Harold the giraffe and will continue lessons back in the classroom using workbooks given to them following the program.

We also had fresh new carpet laid in Kindergarten, 5/6, the Library and 3/4 annexe, which has made such a difference to the feel of these work spaces.

This week we have a visit from the Tapstar Water Show on Wednesday, for students in K-4. Tapstar is a water saving hero who educates children and adults alike on the importance of saving water in and around the home.
