The students were treated to stories and oral histories from local Jerringa Elders and Jerrinja community members as well as a talk from Jordi Lenoy, a Proud Murray man who is currently serving in the Royal Australian Navy. I'd like to take this opportunity to thank Aunty Grace, Uncle Rodney, Charlie Ashby, Rodney Carpenter and Jordi Lenoy for making our day so memorable and reminding us of what a beautifully rich, culturally sensitive area we are lucky enough to live in. Huge thanks must also go to our wonderful P&C who catered for, cooked and fed all that attended on the day. It was a monumental effort which they made look effortless. Many, many messages of praise came in for their efforts and for their wonderful food - so thank you! I have already been told what we organised for the day will be very hard to beat. Next year we have the privilege of travelling to Culburra Public School to participate in their event. We hope next year many of you can join us.

The week ahead sees our Year 5 and 6 students attend the Environment Expo at the Shoalhaven Entertainment centre and on Friday Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be walking to the river to hear from a group of people who care about the health and management of the Shoalhaven River.
