Dear Parents,

The term is flying by and with only 5 weeks to go we still have so much to achieve!

Coming home today will be a note regarding our Whole School Aquatic Safety Program. This is the same program that we ran last year and was much enjoyed by all. Please take your time to read through the note and complete the necessary paperwork attached. A separate note is required for each child. It is anticipated all students K-6 will attend as there is no cost to parents and it covers outcomes from the PDHPE syllabus.

Please return all notes by **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November** to allow us adequate time to compile the necessary paperwork for the program. We are planning to conclude the program by having an interschool Swimming carnival for students 8 years and over. The date for this has been tentatively set for 4<sup>th</sup> December. ## P & C:

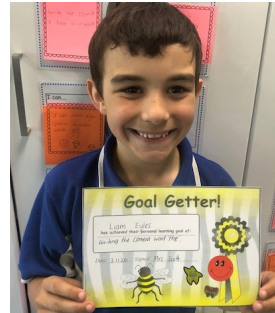
AGM for 2020 will be held in the school library on the 1st December at 6.15pm.

The P & C are looking for more volunteers to help with the pub raffle. See the attached flyer.

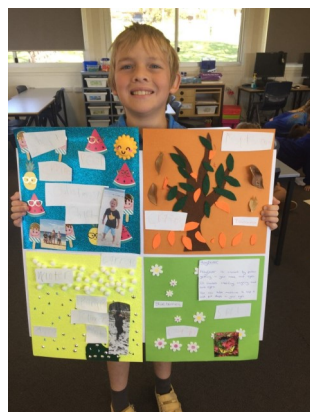
## Book Club:
