Dear Parents,

Results are in! Congratulations to Caitlin Cox –Senior Girls Swimming Champion for 2020!

Well done also to Eli Caswell, Tyson Wilkins and Huey Piert, who along with Caitlin, will represent us at this years district swimming carnival to be held on Thursday 27th February at Nowra Swimming Pool. We wish them all the best.

Last week I had the privilege of convening a Small Schools Network Meeting for the 5 small schools that make up our community of small schools (Greenwell Point, Terara, Falls Creek, Nowra Hill and Kangaroo Valley). One of the hot topics for discussion was the swimming carnival and how we could, as our schools grow to capacity in numbers, cater for a small schools carnival at the same time as allowing adequate time for all students who want to have a go and compete (some races were unable to be held due to time running out on the day).
