

## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to all of our students and families. It was a sea of happy smiling faces as I went to visit rooms today.

Thank you so much for your ongoing support and patience during the few months and with the phased return to school.

All schools returned to full on-campus learning from today and all schools will ensure their operations are in line with the Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) and NSW Health guidelines. Additional cleaning will occur throughout the day and extra time is dedicated to overnight cleaning.

The return to school however does not mean we return to 'normal' operations.

Some important things to note:

- **Hand washing will be continuously encouraged and sanitiser is readily available for use.**
- Due to social distancing measures, **parents must only enter the site if they have phoned ahead previously.** Please "Kiss and Drop" your child off at your designated school gate and collect them again from the same location in the afternoon.
- **Uniform orders can still be placed.** Please phone ahead or send these in with your child.
- **Any child presenting with an illness will be sent home.** Please keep your children home if they are sick and phone the school to inform their teacher.
- **Every child requires their own water bottle.** The bubblers are currently out of use. Water bottles are available for purchase from the front office. These are \$12 and can be paid for by your child.
- Where possible **please provide your child with their own pencil case and stationery items.**
- **Canteen is non-operational** until further notice.
- **Parents and Citizens meetings (P&C) are postponed** until further notice.
- There will unfortunately be **no whole school assemblies, excursions, nor social gatherings until further notice.** We will however attempt to have stage assemblies and post details of these on our social media page.
- Please remember to **stay socially distanced at the school gates** for your own and others personal safety.

We hope we can return to normality soon.

We welcome Ms Scott who will be teaching Kindergarten whilst Ms Brown is on

leave. Ms Scott has already been in contact with most kindergarten parents and many of you may recognise her as she worked closely last term with 5/6 and Ms Weekes. We have also been fortunate enough to be given an additional teacher, Ms Quinn, two days per week for the next 5 weeks to help student adjust back into school routines. Welcome Ms Quinn.
