SCHOOL PLANING AND EVALUATION

The staff at Greenwell Point Public School are currently working hard to evaluate our overall progress for the past three years in order to take stock, examine the evidence, celebrate our achievements and refocus our efforts and resources in a cohesive plan for the next four years. Parents and carers are an invaluable part of this process so this week we have included a survey we would like all of our families to complete.

We are essentially asking for your thoughts about a number of issues. We have been very much guided by the Alice Springs Declaration on Educational Goals for Young Australians. This declaration is an agreed upon vision (amongst States and Territories) for young Australians.

Please return the completed surveys before 8th September 2020 to allow us adequate time to collate the information. Please note the surveys are anonymous and the information will not be shared outside of the school.

COVID UPDATE/SAFETY AND HYGIENE

We need to continue to be vigilant ensuring that staff and students do not attend school or work if they are unwell.

Students absent or sent home due to flu-like symptoms need to be tested. Staff and students must not return to school or work until they return a negative COVID-19 result and are symptoms free.

Schools must sight the negative COVID-19 test result prior to allowing students and staff to return to school.
