PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Dear Parents,

It's that time of year again when cold and flu symptoms become more common. At present, we have a high number of staff and students presenting with cold and flu symptoms. If your child is displaying a cough or runny nose due to a cold or virus please arrange alternate care for them away from school.

If your child has time away from attending school, please send in a written note, the slip from the absence booklet, or a doctor's certificate to avoid an unjustified absence on your child's record.

We are also noticing a rise in head lice cases in the school once again. If you could please check your child's hair regularly and then treat with an appropriate head lice treatment it would be appreciated. It may take more than one treatment to be rid of the lice and subsequent eggs.

It has come to our attention that a number of students are leaving the school grounds in the afternoon without sighting a parent at the gate. Some students have not demonstrated safe road practices as a result, which has been concerning to staff. Please remind your child of how they are to get home in the afternoon safely and encourage them not to leave the grounds if you are not there.
