PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Dear Parents,

We hope you had an enjoyable school holiday period and are safe, happy and healthy.

It was wonderful to see so many smiling happy faces and hear the stories of the children's holidays.

Please read this important information about returning to school this term.

We are classified as regional NSW so:

- We will be face to face teaching and learning at school.
- Primary school children DO NOT need to wear masks.
- Social distancing and all hygiene measures will be in place.
- Restricted access to non-essential visitors is in place (including parents) - no parents on site; including at the office or at assemblies. If you need to enter the site you must phone ahead, wear a mask and use the QR code located at the gates.
- Drop off and pick up will be outside the school gates as we have done previously (we encourage adults to stay in cars where possible).
- Our canteen is non operational for a few weeks and uniform shop will operate- online orders or send orders with students.
- All staff and essential visitors are to use the QR codes to check in and out of school premises. This is in line with practices for all workplaces across NSW.
- Any student, teacher or staff member with any symptoms, or who is feeling unwell, should not attend school and should get a COVID test immediately. Anyone who has been off sick from school will be required to return a negative COVID test before being permitted to return to school. Students with flu-like symptoms will continue to be sent home from school.
- Students and staff who have attended any venue of concern identified by NSW Health should follow NSW Health advice.
- Obviously things can change quickly, so we need to be prepared for learning from home if there is a local case, which we are ready to do.
