Dear Parents,

The weeks are flying past and we are inching closer and closer to the busiest time of the year, particularly in schools.

Please note there have been important changes to the dates of our swimming scheme. <u>The last day for the 'Swimming Scheme' is now Thursday</u> <u>1st December.</u>

1st December. On Friday 2nd December students who will be turning 8 years of age or those older than 8, in 2023 and who are intending on competing in the 2023 Small School Swimming Carnival, will be undergoing testing to ensure they meet the requirements of:

- -correct stroke
- ability to meet the required distance of 50m without stopping
- -complete their laps within required cut off times for competition.

This means that students who are in Years K and Year 1, and those not turning 8 next year or intending on competing, will not be required to bring their swimming gear on Friday 2nd December. Normal classroom activities for these students will be provided back at school.

It is anticipated at this point that the Small Schools District Carnival will be held within the first 3 weeks of Term 1, 2023. More information about the carnival will be made available in early 2023.
