PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Dear Parents,

The term is now in full swing! Before we know it the week will be over again and will be heading closer to the halfway point of the term.

This Friday sees our first school assembly for the term. Given that everything has been 'safe' at school and we have had no outbreaks, I am making the decision to bring the whole school together this Friday to see our SRC members presented with their badges. Whilst the students are coming together, we still have restrictions on visitors so we will post any photos of award winners to our social media page.

Come Monday 28th February (providing no outbreaks occur before then) I will also be removing the restrictions on class cohorting. This means that children will again be allowed to mix with their peers on the playground and move freely around the school. Classes will be able to combine and also singing and dancing lessons can resume. I know many children have waited a long time for this and we can't wait either.

Attached to this weeks newsletter is a copy of the Department of Education's Code of Conduct for students. In the coming weeks the Department of Education will be releasing a new behaviour strategy aimed at providing clearer guidelines, practical strategies and support services to promote pro-social behaviour. Schools across the state will be using these to implement a consistent whole school approach to supporting children. I will be seeking feedback regarding the strategy soon.
