PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Dear Parents.

It was wonderful to be able to hold the schools cross country race last week. Although we didn't get to run the Willandra track as planned, the option to run along our beautiful waterfront right here in Greenwell Point was just as amazing. The sun was shining for the event, which just showcased this wonderful area. The best part of this years event though was that all of the children (K-6) were able to take part.

Kindergarten and students under the age of 8 ran a modified distance and children 8 years and over ran the entire course.

This year the selection for the district Cross Country was different as we were unable to compete alongside the other small schools. Students who ran in first, second or third place in their age category (Boys and girls 8/9's,10's,11's, 12/13's) will be invited to attend the district carnival on 18th May.

Well done to all that ran and an extra congratulations to those going off to district. Thank you to the mums, dads, and other family members who came along to watch and help out, and to the community members who left or sent such lovely messages of support.

HEAD LICE

Unfortunately, they are back and with vengeance! We ask that all parents check their children's hair this week and over the coming weeks as a matter of urgency as we have had many reports of students coming home with head lice. Now is the time to be vigilant about regularly inspecting your child's hair.

Did you know that head lice actually bite the scalp and make life uncomfortable and often painful for the host?

Many different treatment options are available from chemists and supermarkets. Another option that was passed on from a parent was to wash the child's hair with a treatment, then drench the hair in a cheap conditioner and allow this to sit on the hair for up to 1/2 hour. Comb through before rinsing the conditioner off and check for eggs and lice. Once this is complete, rinse the hair and dry as per normal. Once the hair is completely dry, run a hair straightener across the hair. Parents have found this effective in killing the remaining eggs.

Please only use this option if you feel it is right for you and your child.

Please remember to treat your children's hats and to ensure your child brings their own hat to school that is clearly labelled. Quite often head lice are transmitted by the sharing of hats or by accidentally wearing the hat of another.

NAPLAN

This week and next week, students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 will be sitting their NAPLAN assessments. Please remember that this is a 'point in time' assessment that schools use to harvest information about student achievement. Results from the NAPLAN assessments will not be available to parents until later in the year.

CANTEEN & UNIFORMS

It was wonderful to see the canteen open again. The food in our school canteen is amazing thanks to the dedicated band of parents who make and serve our food. Orders for the canteen can be placed through the 'My School Connect' app. School uniforms also can be purchased and paid for via either the app or website.
