The RATs will be sent home this week to support staff and families to comply with daily testing requirements for close contacts coming/returning to school. Kits can be used for symptomatic testing or for daily testing as part of the close contact requirements. If you require additional tests, please contact the school, however there is a limit supply and when supply ends you will be required to purchase them again.
