Birth Certificates

Our Mia Mia in Nowra is now able to provide children and parents of our school access to fee free birth certificates. The access requirement for a fee free birth certificate is that the parent needs to have either a Health Care Card or Concession Card. Families that don't meet these requirements will still be able to receive a birth certificate however, it will be at cost.

If you would like an application form, please contact the school to have one sent home. You will need to complete the form and attach a copy of valid id and a copy of the parents Concession or Health Care card.
