Gala Day

All 3 teams competed in an inclusive environment against other schools from our local district. It was great to see students from a range of Rugby League backgrounds build their ability and confidence while displaying pride in their school as they cheered on one another from the sideline. Regional Swimming

The 'Greenwell Point Marlin'
On Friday the 10th of March Joshua Grieve (3/4 F) represented Greenwell Point Primary at the 60th South Coast Primary Schools Swimming Championships held at Dapto pool.

Joshua qualified in 5 events for the day. This being the Junior (8-10 years) Boys 200m Individual Medley, the 50m Backstroke, Breaststroke and Butterfly events as well as the 10 years 50m Freestyle event.

He swam amazingly on the day finishing with 6^{th} in the Backstroke, 5^{th} in the Breaststroke and 4^{th} in the Butterfly event. A special mention goes to Joshua's effort in the 10yrs boys 50m Freestyle where he finished a very close 2nd place as well as his tremendous effort in winning the Jr Boys 200m Individual Medley event. He won this race by a massive 10 seconds!

Joshua will now represent South Coast PSSA at the NSW State Swimming Championships on the $5^{\rm th}$ & $6^{\rm th}$ of April at Sydney International Aquatic Centre in Homebush. Good Luck Joshua!
