You may have noticed that we are in the process of upgrading our school fencing. School Security and Schools Infrastructure have made the decision to replace our old and broken fencing and upgrade the fencing in line with most schools in NSW.

While it is sad to see the old fencing disappear, we welcome new secure fencing that will hopefully reduce the increased number of break-ins and vandalism episodes that have occurred over the last 2 years. We also welcome the thought that during school hours, the students are safe from harm and danger.

We will continue to work with school security advocating for the continuation of the share our space during the school holidays, but we cannot guarantee that this service will continue. The new fencing is expected to be completed by the end of August, with 4 entry and exit points.

Please note that due to the new fencing, the gates will not be opened until approximately 8:30 am. Please ensure your children do not arrive before this time unless you have made arrangements with administration staff to be on-site before this time. All gates will be locked after students have exited, with the main gate remaining open until the last staff member leaves.

If you are having difficulty with not being able to drop your children off early, there are still spaces available in the Before and After School Care services currently being offered by Kids Korner in Nowra. Please contact the school if you require more information.
