A Preschool is Coming to GPPS in 2027

We're excited to share that Greenwell Point Public School is part of the NSW Government's \$769 million investment to deliver 100 new public preschools across the state. As part of this initiative, a brand-new preschool will be built on the east side of our school grounds, accessible from Jervis Street.

The Greenwell Point Public Preschool will provide a safe and engaging learning environment for up to 20 children per day. The facility will feature two purpose-built preschool rooms, a quality outdoor play space, administration and amenities areas, a staff kitchen, and storage facilities. Construction is expected to be completed in time for Day 1, Term 1, 2027.

Early planning is complete, and we're thrilled to announce that Patterson Building Group Pty Limited has been appointed as the construction contractor. We'll continue working closely with them to bring this exciting project to life!


